Reason For Supplemental Report:

On Monday, April 14, 2025, at approximately 8:30 am, I Deputy State Fire Marshal Andrew Browne was contacted by Deputy State Fire Marshal Jessica Sinerius regarding a fire that occurred on Saturday, April 12, 2025, within the Minot Rural Fire Department's district.

I contacted Assistant Chief (AC) Rob Knuth of the Minot Rural Fire Department regarding the request. During the conversation it was agreed that I would not be responding, and no assistance was being requested from the State Fire Marshal's Office. This incident report is to document the call that our office received on Saturday, April 12, 2025, regarding the fire investigation.

Remarks:

On Saturday, April 12, 2025, at approximately 2:14 pm, Minot Rural Fire Department was dispatched to a structure fire at 6500 55th St. NE, Minot. AC Knuth stated a North Dakota Highway Patrol Trooper was the first on scene and flames coming from a second story bedroom window. AC Knuth stated that property occupants were not home at the time of the fire, and no injuries or fatalities were reported. AC Knuth reported no incendiary indicators.

AC Knuth stated upon the arrival of the fire department the structure was fully engulfed. AC Knuth stated the structure and structure members had collapsed into the basement. AC Knuth stated most of the combustible materials were consumed. AC Knuth stated adjacent farmland was ignited through extension from the structure. AC Knuth stated the fire occurred within the structure and it was not known the cause of the fire. AC Knuth stated no request was needed due to significant damage to the structure and the contents of the structure were in the basement and consumed.

No further assistance was requested from the Minot Rural Fire Department.
