Reason For Supplemental Report:

On May 14, 2025, I, Deputy State Fire Marshal Andrew Browne received a telephone call from our Bismarck Office regarding a wildland fire in New Rockford, ND. Fire Chief Tony O'Connor of the New Rockford Fire Department was requested a telephone call.

I contacted Fire Chief Tony O'Connor and was notified that the New Rockford Fire Department had responded to a wildland fire on May 13, 2025.

No response from the North Dakota State Fire Marshal's Office was requested.

Remarks:

The fire occurred near the intersection of 24th Street NE and 75th Avenue NE, Bush Township, Eddy County, ND.

Fire Chief O'Connor stated the New Rockford Fire Department was called to a wildland fire at approximately 11:42 am. Fire Chief O'Connor stated the fire started along the southeast corner of the intersection above near the roadway. There were adjacent powerline poles that were nearby the area but were not damaged.

Fire Chief O'Connor stated the fire had already burned approximately 10 acres upon the fire department's arrival. The fire had consumed approximately 400 acres in total.

Fire Chief O'Connor did not know the specific cause of the fire other than it had started along the roadway in the southeast corner of the intersection of 24th St. NE and 75th Ave NE, Eddy County, ND. Fire Chief O'Connor stated the fire conditions for the date of the fire were high.

Fire Chief O'Connor did not need a response from the State Fire Marshal's Office at this time and wanted to document the occurrence of the fire.
