Reason For Supplemental Report:
<p>On August 22, 2025, I, Deputy State Fire Marshal (DSFM) Kaylyn Lucas, was contacted by State Radio regarding a fire in Granville, ND. Fire Chief Shane Thull was requesting a telephone call.</p> <p>I contacted Fire Chief Shane Thull and was notified that Granville Rural Fire Protection District had responded to a bee hive fire on August 22, 2025.</p> <p>No response from the North Dakota State Fire Marshal's Office was requested.</p>

Remarks:
<p>The fire occurred near the junction of 59th St N and 6th Ave N, Granville, ND, 58741.</p> <p>Fire Chief Shane Thull reported that a beehive had reported on fire. No structures were impacted. Fire Chief Shane Thull reported that the center beehive was on fire. The beehive was located in the middle of a pasture.</p> <p>The fire department dismantled and extinguished the beehive. No other beehives were on fire, just the center one. Fire Chief Shane Thull described that the area was green, had high humidity, and recent rainstorms went through, making the fire was unusual.</p> <p>Fire Chief Shane Thull wanted to report on the fire due it the unusual circumstances of the fire.</p> <p>Fire Chief Shane Thull mentioned that another fire district may have also been called out to a beehive fire a day or two prior to Granville's beehive fire.</p>
